Presenting Sega's new compact Windsor series with Automatic Jackpot



Windsor Crazy Bells

"Crazy Bells" is SEGA's latest Automatic Jackpot machine, presenting duplex payout features. It offers Criss Cross payout of 18 coins whenever the three "£" signs are visible anywhere in the window, and there are 27 possible positions. In addition to the Criss Cross, Crazy Bells provides a special "Free Flow" feature. When three bells are hit, the machine pays 20 coins and continues to deliver 20 coins for each of the next nine consecutive plays, provided that the checkered background on the first reel shows.



Windsor Playboy

"Playboy"—a real cool machine with a new approach in payouts. One cherry pays three; other pays run six, twelve, sixteen, and twenty for bells;—bars or melons pay jackpot. Still another feature is the wild rabbit that pays 20 coins and has 27 winning combinations, if three rabbits show in any position in the window.

Windsor Mad Money

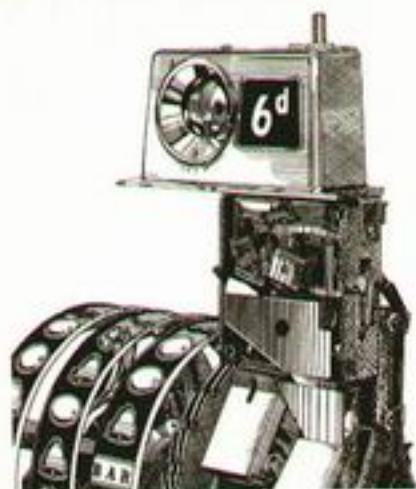
"Mad Money" offers an old favorite in a new cabinet styling. The Mad Money feature pays off 18 coins in 27 different combinations whenever the three faces appear any place in the window.



Windsor Derby

"Derby" has more going for you than a day at the races. Spelling out the word "Derby" pays 18 coins and who is about to leave the machine with only one or two letters left to go. Derby is a sure winner. It is built into the standard Windsor cabinet with no outside additions.





Windsor Coin Feed System

All new Windsors come equipped with a slug rejector as part of the coin head assembly. This coin head assembly consists of the coin entry ring, the reject button for removing bent coins, the denomination glass, the slug rejector mounting bracket and the slug rejector, all in one assembly and attached directly to the mechanism. This arrangement eliminates "down time" caused by misalignment between the coin entry chute and slug rejector. This alignment is set at the factory and no other adjustments are required.

Windsor Mechanism Release

Windsors new electrical mechanism release gives the player the advantage of an effortless handle action, without the loss of the slot machine feeling. Abuse of the mechanism by pulling on the handle without putting in a coin has been overcome in the new release system which allows the handle free movement when no coin is inserted.



Cash Box and Money Bowl

When designing the Windsor line no effort was spared to make all components functional and still eliminate the troubles that have shown up from time to time in other machines. The too-small cash box has been overcome by making use of the entire area under the mechanism to serve as a cash box. The spilling of coins during payouts has been prevented by the use of a new shaped and deeper money bowl. This easily accessible money bowl extends the width of the machine.
