Problem: No Feedback from the Steering Motor

Cause: Mis-wiring of the connector at CN5 of the I/O Board.


Correction: Perform the test listed below, and follow the appropriate instructions.

Put Machine into "Drive BD Test"

Read the value next to the line "Handle = ". If it is "FF" then proceed with the steps below. If the value
is at or near "80" then your machine is fine, and no correction is necessary.

Steps to correct viring problem

- 1. Twn Power Off. Open the PC Board Cage and locate the I/O Board (837-10539)
- 2. Locate CN5 and unplug it from the board (See Figure 1)
- 3. Move the White / Black Wire from Pin 11 of that connector to Pin 12. (See Figure 2)
- Re-install the connector, and power up your machine to verify proper operation. Close up machine.
