

SPEEDWAY MECHANISM

The M1 operates on a 6d coin or check for one pull, coins go to the cash box and checks to the payout tube. Both Speedways M1—M2 have the famous trouble-free SEGA mechanism; this mechanism has passed through years of improvements and updating to reach a peak of dependable operation.

M1 PLAY FEATURES

The M1 includes the Grand Prix, Bonus and Criss-Cross payout features, plus the standard eight payout combinations. Grand Prix can be made from four winning combinations and for the next nine consecutive plays pays ten coins on each play where the background on the first reel is checkered.

ANTI-CHEATING

Safety devices have been built into both M1 and M2 mechanisms to overcome cheating; the free pulling handle, which is disconnected from the mechanism when no coin has been deposited, eliminates the abuse that is usually inflicted on the mechanism.

M2 PLAY FEATURES

The M2 operates on a 6d coin for 2 plays or 1 token for 1 play, with coins going to the cash box and tokens to the payout tube. M2 offers Criss-Cross payout of 5 shillings, Bonus payout of 20 coins and a Grand Prix payout. This latter drops a Special Award Token and continues to drop tokens for the next 9 consecutive plays, as long as the checkered background shows.
