

## SEGA SECRETS

**DOUBLE DRAGON™:** Here's a way to take out two of the Black Warriors at once. Wait until they are almost on you. They will be so close that they touch each other. Then let fly with a leaping kick. You'll get both of them at the same time. Do this three or four times and you will have them!



**POWER STRIKE™:** There are two things to remember to get farther in Power Strike. The first is to get a number weapon, then keep picking up as many of that same number as you can. This will advance your timer to the beginning and will give you more power. The second is to keep picking up the yellow power capsules. This will double, then triple the power of your primary laser. Also, there is a ten-life continue mode hidden in the title screen. You can find it by pressing Down, Right, Down, Down, Left, Right, Up, Right with your D-Button, and then pressing Button 1.



**SPACE HARRIER™ 3-D:** There are all sorts of hidden features in this wild game! To access them, first you must make the score board.
