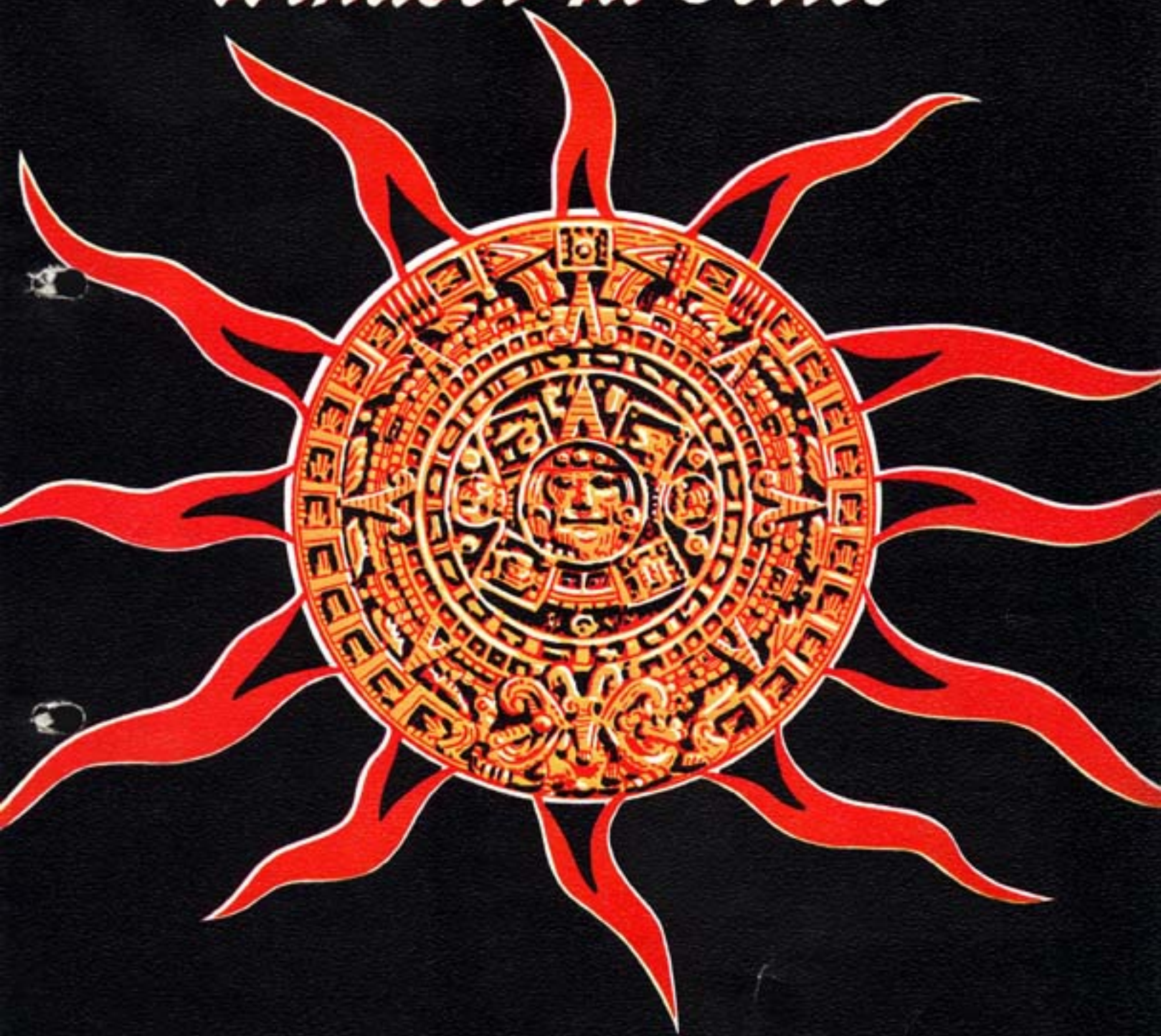

The AZTEC penny Windsor also
has the new SEGA coin feed
system, which is complete
in one unit.

This unique coin head assembly
is attached directly to the
mechanism and incorporates
in a single unit the coin entry
ring, the reject button for
removing bent coins, the
denomination glass, the slug
rejector and bracket.

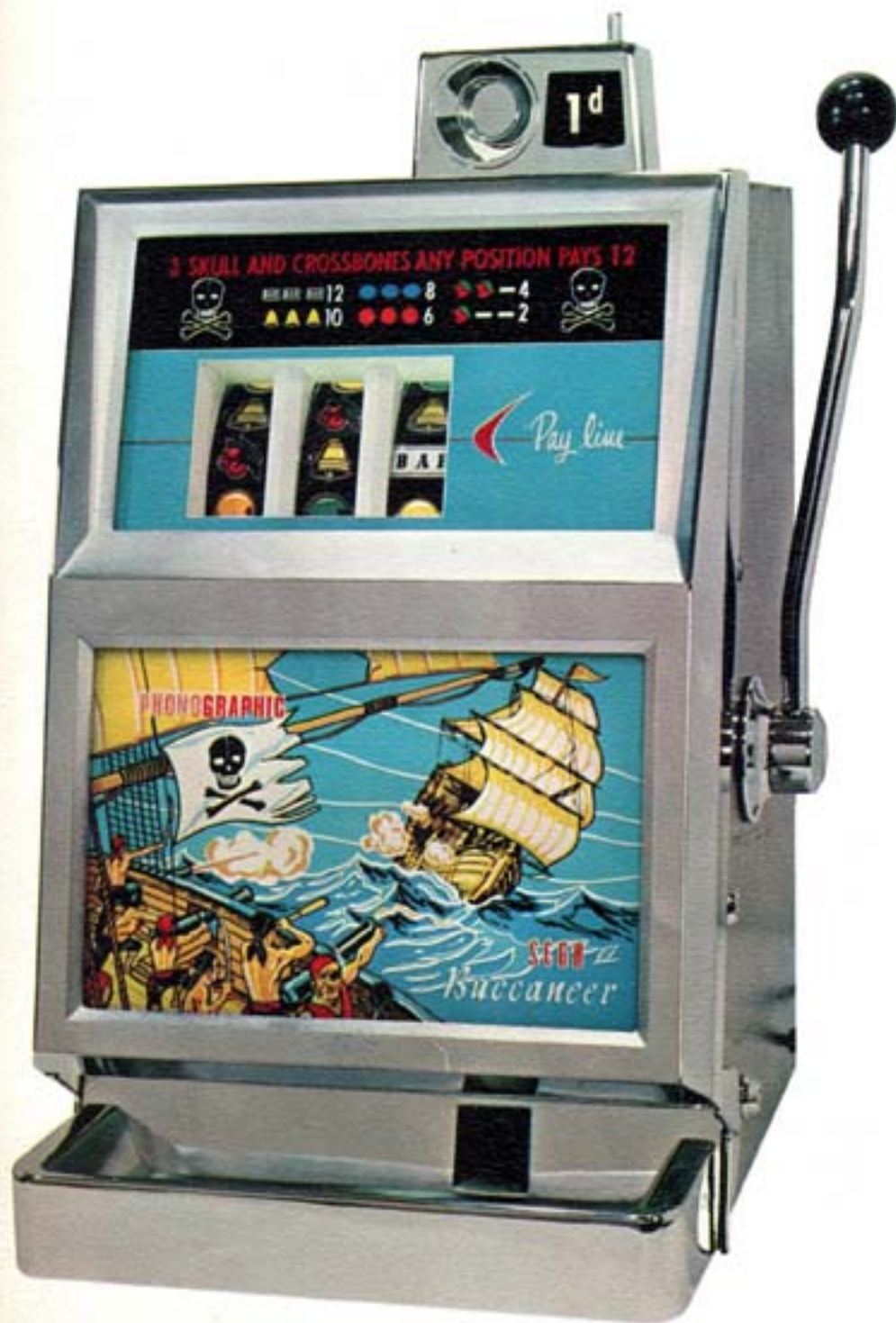
This face symbol on the payout line of the first and third reels only, pays maximum. Other pays include the

criss cross payoff of bars in twenty-seven positions. Windsor Sailor has the SEGA mechanism that is built to take a day-in-day-out beating. Abuse of the machine by pulling on the handle without putting in a coin has been eliminated. This was achieved by incorporating into the mechanism a new handle release system which allows the handle free movement when no coin is inserted.
